The course is for every violinist or violist with a conservatory or university degree, who would like to become an ESA approved Suzuki[™] violin or viola teacher, and for those who have already done one or more levels and want to go on with the next level or refresh the previous. We also accept conservatory students on the course.

- In this course you will upgrade your teaching skills and expand your understanding of pedagogics and Suzuki[™] Method
- As a new thing you will be able to take level 1 or 2 on viola, or a conversion course. On violin we cover all 5 levels.

- The Course consists of 6 weekends alternating between Albertslund (Copenhagen) and Aarhus. You are only allowed to miss one weekend, if you want to do the exam, unless you have a special agreement with the Trainers of the course.

 Price is 12000 DKK/1600 €. Special offer for Students in Academy of Music or Universities 7000 DKK/935 €. If you want to take an extra year at the same level, the price for the second (and third ...) year is 6000 DKK/800 €. The fee is to be paid by Oct. 1st, 2025.

The fee can be divided into three payments (Oct. 1st, Dec. 1st, Feb. 1st) Additional fee for the exam including accompanist on 1500 DKK/200 \in for level 1, 2 or 3 and 2000 DKK/270 \in (for level 4 or 5), this is to be paid by May 1st). If you bring your own accompanist (this should be announced before May 1st, the exam fee is reduced by 300 DKK/40 \in .

When the course start you will receive an invoice. If you sign up and drop out after the first weekend you don't need to pay.
